Abstract (limited to 150 words)	<p>This talk will explore commonalities and differences in various methodological approaches toward evidence mapping (evidence and gap maps, EGMs), illustrate recent examples of EGMs, and discuss their use in informing research and policy. The session is part of the process for the Campbell Collaboration to establish policies and procedures for publishing EGMs in the Campbell Library. This a review of different approaches to producing and using evidence maps by different organisations (Collaboration for Environmental Science (CEE), EvidenceMap.org, Evidence Based Synthesis Program (ESP), Evidence Gap Maps (3ie), Scientific Uncertainties (SBU), and Global Evidence Mapping Initiative).</p> <p>What we aim to achieve from this paper presentation is to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Identify organisations that produce evidence maps • Study the different approaches used for generating the evidence maps. • Identify uniqueness and similarities in each step (Inclusion criteria, screening, search, coding and use) • Discuss areas of commonality and dissimilarity for each step between the different organizations. • Propose some common standards for evidence maps.
